Isolation/Quarantine Rules: If your child needs to isolate for testing positive for Covid-19, or quarantine due to being identified at a close contact of someone with Covid-19, the first day counts as absent. Please email your child's teacher of their continued absence. If your child needs a Chromebook or iPad or school material, please arrange for someone to pick them up a school. On day 2, the teacher will send the link to the Quarantine Remote Learning Plan to your child to access for the remainder of their time. There will be a check-in by a Doyon staff member with your child and a live link to a math lesson for grades 3-5 with Ms. O'Connell each day. This plan is only for students who are mandated per our nurse, Mrs. Siobhan Lemire per the Ipswich BOH, CDC and DESE guidelines.
