PRESCHOOL SERVICES

Ipswich Public Schools provides preschool services for students identified as requiring specialized instruction. Referrals may come from parents, pediatricians, Early Intervention, private preschools, daycare providers, and other agencies.

The preschool team in the student's neighborhood school will review the student's eligibility for Special Education or related services. Eligible students can begin receiving services on or after their third birthday.

Screening evaluations are held in the spring. Notice of the screening appears on the District website, in the school newsletters, in Birth –To- Three mailings, and in the local news. The purpose of the screening is to identify eligible students who may not have been identified by other sources.
