Good Evening,

I want to provide you with updated information regarding our school closure due to the COVID-19 Outbreak. I hope that this message finds you all healthy and safe.

As I indicated on Sunday night, the Ipswich Public Schools are transitioning to a Remote Learning Model. I am proud to announce the launch of a new website for parents and students. As we developed this model, we took into consideration the ages of the students, capacity and access to technology, feedback from the survey, and an acknowledgement of the current crisis situation we are all dealing with. The Remote Learning Model is designed to engage all students in learning, build on previously taught skills, and at the high school level, work toward course completion.

When you click on the link below you will be taken to the Remote Learning Website. Near the top of the page, there is a banner that provides you with a quick tour of the website. The website is very user friendly. The home page defines Remote Learning according to State guidelines and then what it means here in Ipswich. Tabs for each school, food service, technology and additional resources are easy to see and navigate. Each tab contains specific information and more detailed plans for each level; elementary, middle and high school.
