This first round will include an update on the current state of the elementary school buildings and a discussion with some framing questions around community values.

The second round of listening sessions are scheduled for September 27 and October 12 and will be based on feedback from the first round, with discussions focused on possible paths forward.

The School Committee is committed to a transparent and inclusive process, and hopes the community will bring their ideas and enthusiasm about what a future elementary experience might look like for our youngest learners.
